

MPN&MPNr-EuroNet Training Schools

MPN&MPNr-EuroNet started to organize international training schools in 2011. Training schools dedicated to MPNs are usually held in May, in Nîmes (FR). Training schools dedicated to congenital erythrocytosis are typically organized in Coimbra (PT) or in Barcelona (ES). Each training school lasts two days and a half. Up to 10 trainees can attend. Preference is given to early stage researchers (ESRs) and biologists with less than ten years from their last degree. Theory is taught in morning classes, practice is performed in afternoon classes.
